

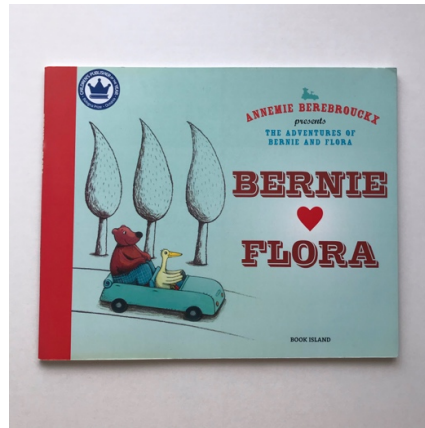

To find at home:

- Cardboard or cereal box (A4 size)
- White or green paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Paint (or felt tips or crayons)
- Wool or yarn
- Sellotape
- Glue
- Wooden skewer, garden stick or lollipop stick
- Print out our template PDF

What to do:

Cut out the circle templates from the pdf sheet.

Draw around them onto a piece of cardboard or cereal box. Cut out.

Paint the cardboard circles on one side. Leave to dry.

Snip all around the edge of each circle as shown on the template.

Cut a length of wool approx. 60cm long.

Slot the end of the wool into one of the notches you cut.

Tape the short end to the back of the circle.

Wind the wool around the circle back to front by slotting into the notches.

At the end of the wool tape the short end at the back of the circle.

Repeat with a different coloured wool if you'd like.

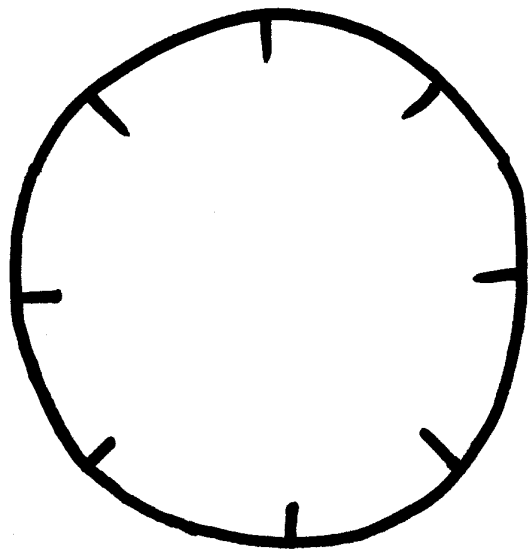
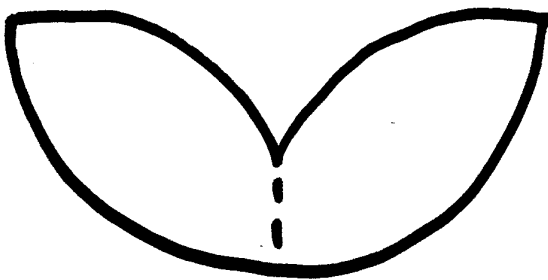
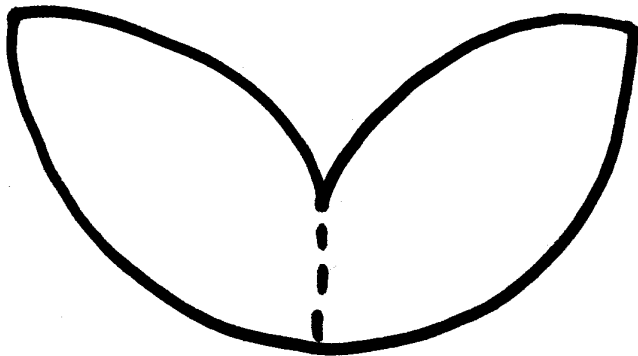
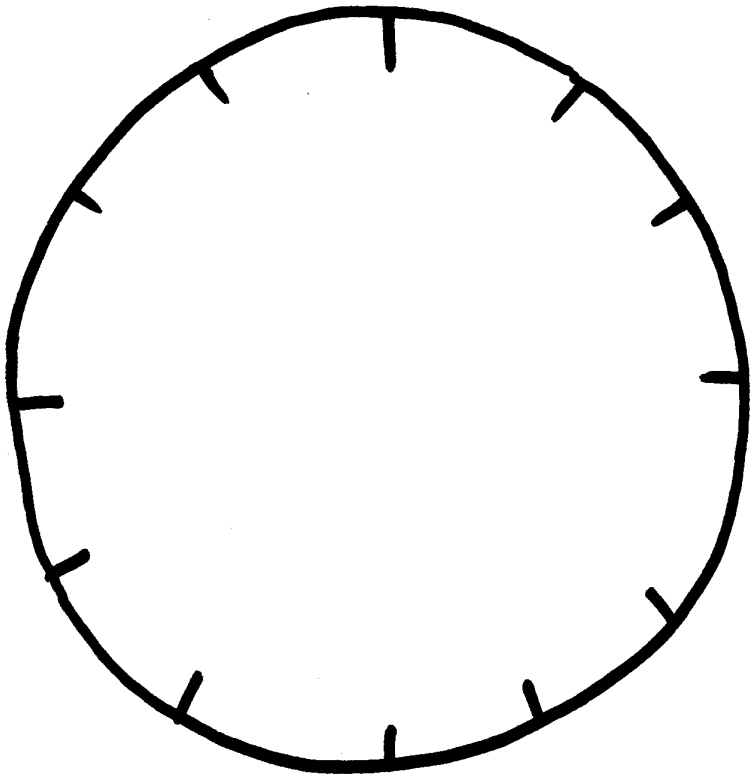
Tape a stick to the back of the woven circle.

Cut out the leaf template from the pdf sheet.

Draw around it onto the white or green paper (if you're using white paper you can colour it in with paints, felt pens or crayons) and cut out.

Fold the leaf in half, glue on the inside and fold around the stick.

Why not make a bunch of flowers to put in a pot or vase at home? Or send to a friend in the post?
