To find at home:

- Cardboard or cereal box (A4 size)
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Paint (or felt tips or crayons)
- Glue
- Black felt tip or marker
- Wool or yarn
- Sellotape
- Pipe cleaner
- Print out our template PDF

What to do:

Cut out the whale template out from the pdf.

Draw around it onto a piece of cardboard or cereal box.

Cut out.

Paint the cardboard whale shape.

Leave to dry.

Cut out the mouth and the eye shape from the whale template.

Draw around them onto one of the cardboard off cuts.

Cut out.

Glue onto the painted whale shape.

Draw a pupil on the eye and teeth on to the mouth.

Glue on to the whale shape.

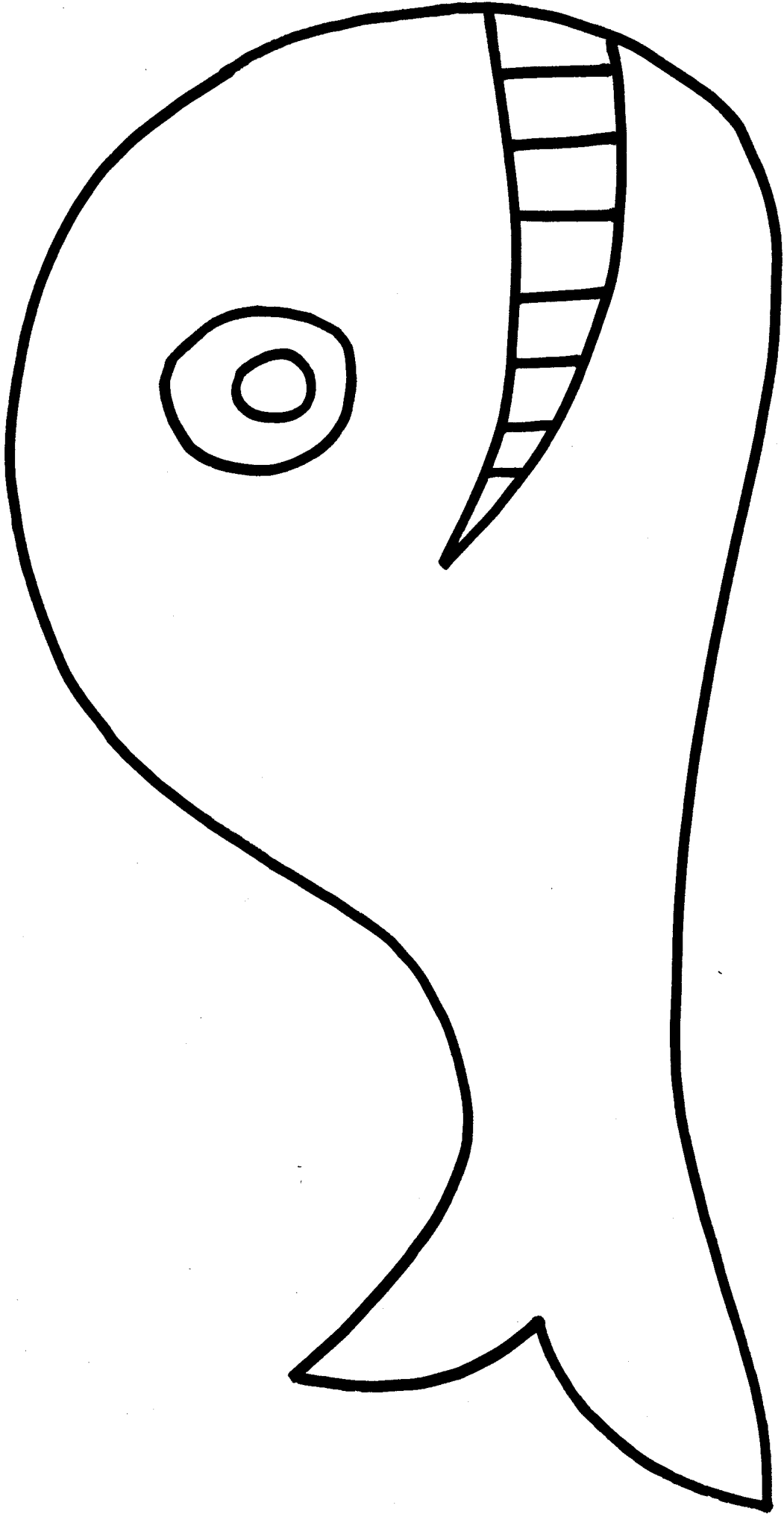
Cut some yarn into approx. 20cm lengths.

Turn the whale over and glue all across the bottom side.

Stick ends of wool all along the bottom.

Place a length of sellotape across the wool ends to secure.

Hang it up on your wall.
