To find at home:

- Cardboard or cereal box
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Glue
- Sellotape
- Paints, felt tips or crayons
- Print out template PDF

What to do:

Cut out the template pieces and draw around them onto a piece of cardboard or cereal box.

You will need three walls and one wall with the door.

Cut out.

Paint all the pieces (or colour with felt tips or crayons).

Paint a piece of cardboard or cereal box and cut into brick shapes.

Glue the brick shapes onto the four castle walls.

Cut out the flag pole and flag, colour in and stick together.

To assemble the castle, lay all four walls next to each other and tape together on the wrong side.

Stand up in a cube shape and stick together the last join with sellotape on the inside.

Tape the flag pole to the inside of a castle wall.
